



Safety Agreement

In order to maintain the safety of the young people participating in our youth ministry programs, we as youth ministers agree to:

- Start and end Youth Ministry events and meetings on time.
- Provide only adult chaperones that are fingerprinted and trained in the Diocesan Safe Environment program.
- Provide at least one adult chaperone for every 8 participants at all youth ministry gatherings.
- Two Adults will stay on site to wait for all participants to be picked up/leave from youth ministry gatherings.

Participants agree to the following:

- Sign in at all youth ministry events and meetings.
- Stay at event until the end or provide written permission letter signed by a parent or legal guardian to leave an event during event hours.
- Young people are asked to leave the property within a short time after events have concluded (if driving self.)
- All young people will be asked to stay within boundaries designated by the youth minister for each event/gathering. This includes break times. (For example, participants will be asked to stay inside the youth room during a youth night even while on a "break". Obvious exceptions include going to the restroom, etc.)

Parents agree to the following:

- Pick up young people at the published time the event or meeting ends.
- Consider chaperoning at least one youth ministry event during the year.

Diocesan policy states that drivers must be age 25 or older to transport to or from youth ministry gatherings.
